

## Stitch Definitions:

For convenience, stitch instructions are provided in written out form here, or charted on the following page.

- Left Twist:** Slip 2 to cable needle and hold to front, p1, k2 from cable needle  
**Right Twist:** Slip 1 to cable needle and hold to back, k2, p1 from cable needle  
**C4R:** Slip 2 to cable needle and hold to back, k2, k2 from cable needle  
**C4L:** Slip 2 to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k2 from cable needle  
**C5R:** Slip 2 to cable needle and hold to back, k3, k2 from cable needle  
**C5L:** Slip 3 to cable needle and hold to front, k2, k3 from cable needle

## did you know?

Cloud Chaser is a great pattern to try cabling without a cable needle.

C5R: With your needle held in front of the work, skip the first 2 sts and place the next 3 on the tip of your right needle. Slide all 5 sts off the left needle and put the 2 'free' sts immediately back on the left needle. Replace the 3 sts on the left needle and knit 5.

This way, you've created the twist on the needle before you've even knit a st. Try it. You may find it's a quicker way to work these lovely cables

## Cable Chart A:

Worked over 11 sts

- Row 1: Knit  
 Row 2: Purl  
 Row 3: C5R, k1, C5L  
 Row 4: Purl  
 Row 5: Knit  
 Row 6: Purl  
 Row 7: Knit  
 Row 8: Purl

## Cable Chart B:

Worked over 14 sts

- Row 1: p1, C4L, p4, C4R, p1  
 Row 2: k1, p4, k4, p4, k1  
 Row 3: p1, k2, Left Twist, p2, Right Twist, k2, p1  
 Row 4: k1, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, p2, k1  
 Row 5: p1, k2, p1, Left Twist, Right Twist, p1, k2, p1  
 Row 6: k1, p2, k2, p4, k2, p2, k1  
 Row 7: p1, k2, p2, C4L, p2, k2, p1  
 Row 8: k1, p2, k2, p4, k2, p2, k1  
 Row 9: p1, k2, p1, Right Twist, Left Twist, p1, k2, p1  
 Row 10: k1, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, p2, k1  
 Row 11: p1, k2, Right Twist, p2, Left Twist, k2, p1  
 Row 12: k1, p4, k4, p4, k1
